The increased pace of urbanisation, leading to inadequate delivery of basic services along with confrontation of environment with conventional technology and many other religious practices also add to the degradation of environment, which are having its impact as an enhanced deterioration of urban health due to poor living conditions. This situation is posing crucial challenges before the human society, which is facing the new risks and pressures affecting all of us to the greatest extent. People and the ecosystems would need to adapt to future climate regimes. 2016 ushered official launch of bold and new transformative agenda for the Sustainable Development adopted by the world leaders at UN, which calls on countries to achieve 17 Global Sustainable Development Goals focusing on to wipe out Poverty, Fight inequality and Tackle the climate change asserting on "Transforming our World: the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development". Of these 17 Goals, Climate action is a Goal 13 which says "Take urgent action to combat Climate Change and its impacts by regulating emissions and promoting developments in renewable energy" India being the signatory to this treaty is committed to this agenda for its implementation..

While the governments must necessarily play a leadership role through education, creation of awareness, implementation of various Acts, policies and programmes in letter and spirit along with the provision of infrastructure and overall planning, their policies on science and technology must be geared primarily for the promotion of creative action at the individual and community levels. In India too, the policy makers have begun to voice their concern with ecological and environmental issues. These issues have in recent years become very important in India. The new Fundamental Duties of Citizens, added to the Indian Constitution in 1977-78, make concern for the environment a fundamental duty of all citizens.

The Primary cause for the care and concern for study of Sustainable Development, is environment protection, causes of pollution, impact & the gravity of the climate change affecting human lives, prevailing environmental laws, Policies, particularly in the Indian context, the performance, administration & lacunae of agencies responsible for their implementation inclusive of judicial trends, to make an assessment of public opinion as regards the enforcement of environment and Human Rights, and educate people to inculcate the awareness about the concerns of environment as a prime need of the hour. In summary it is all about creation, dissemination of knowledge and information along with the public awareness where the govt. agencies like Pollution Control Boards, academic institutions are of prime importance and play a crucial role. The environmental laws and government machinery for its implementation plays extremely important role in protecting healthy environment as a basic human right.

The present seminar attempts to make a brief study of prevailing environmental laws, particularly in the Indian context with the Pollution Control Boards as the agency responsible for their implementation in the state, inclusive of judicial trends, to assess & analyze the performance and the challenges before it and National Environment Policy of India in comparison with international environmental standards in addition to the efforts to educate, inculcate the awareness about the concerns of environment in people through Govt. institutions specially created for environment preservation as a regulatory authority.

With this background, understanding the gravity of the situation and need of the hour to save / protect environment to probe into the depth various affecting factors, lapses, loopholes, legal aspects, in the relevant policies and its implementation at the administrative level with the practical approaches to find out the appropriate solutions to the problems, the proposed seminar aims to probe deeper into various relevant issues with the academic discussions of high inputs.
